Be My Valentine

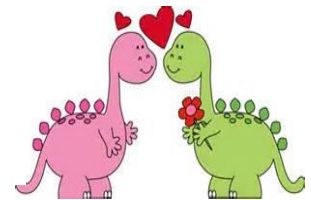
